

International Students Registration Process

Step 1: Report to the International Student Apartment

1. Select a bed (fees vary depending on the bed type).
2. Apply for a phone SIM card (Options: Process it personally at the campus service hub, or request your dorm attendant to arrange doorstep assistance).
3. Register your phone number at the dormitory manager's office and join the WeChat group for international students.



Step 2: Take Required Materials to Rooms 209, 210 and 211 in Training Building



Room 210 (Original copy):

Passport, Academic Certificate, Admission Notice, JW Form, Financial Guarantee Letter, Non-Criminal Record Certificate, Guardianship Authorization Letter for Minors in China (Applicable to minors only), HSK Transcript (Mandatory for academic program applicants)

Room 209 (Photocopy)

Bio-data page of passport, current valid visa page, and latest entry stamp page



Room 211

Collect textbooks.

Step 3: Pay Fees (Via WeChat Pay or Alipay)



Step 4: Students with X1 Visa Need to Apply for Residence Permit (Requires a medical examination)



Step 5: Attend Classes

- Notes:
1. Open a China Construction Bank (CCB) account as soon as possible, which is used for scholarship disbursements.
 2. Before coming to China, you must deposit sufficient funds into your Alipay account to cover tuition fees, accommodation costs, and other related expenses. Those who haven't settled all payments will not be able to apply for a residence permit.
 3. You can take a flight to Kunming Changshui International Airport. After exiting the airport, turn right and take the airport shuttle bus (the last departure is at 9:30 PM, a 7-seater business van) which will drop you off right at the school gate. Additionally, it's recommended that students purchase a local SIM card after arriving on campus, as there are special discounts for student plans.
